The Mouratoglou International School is part of The Mouratoglou Academy where students from all over the world (with over 45 different nationalities) harmoniously combine intensive training, tournaments, and a school curriculum. It is an American Curriculum Private School situated in the South of France (registered with the Ministère français de l'Éducation Nationale – French ministry of education), enrolling an average of 130day students and student-athletes in grades 6 to 12. High school enrollment for the 24-25 academic year is 122 students. Our classroom size does not exceed 16 students. The academic year starts in September and ends in June.

The Mouratoglou International School is passionately dedicated to individually enhancing the prospects of all our students in a safe and personalized environment. We give every student athlete the tools to live their passion, realize their dreams of excellence, and push their limits of the achievable.

Our school does not allow for dual enrollment.


